Corporate Membership	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Includes 100 9-hole vouchers to be used by the corporation or your clients. Must turn in a voucher for every 9 holes played. 20 per cent savings over regular green fees • Have full golf privileges • Have 7 days in advance to reserve tee times • Have no restrictions from play at any time except when previous bookings have been made (i.e.: outside tournaments, member tournaments and members social events. These events will be posted in advance)
Restricted Memberships	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Golfers can only book tee times and play Monday-Friday before 4pm • Have 8 days in advance to reserve tee times
Intermediate Membership (Ages 19 – 24) As of April 1)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have 8 days in advance to reserve tee times • Have no restrictions from play at any time except when previous bookings have been made (i.e.: outside tournaments, member tournaments and members social events.
Junior Membership (Ages 18 and under as of April 1)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can play anytime Monday to Friday • Cannot tee off until 1:00 pm on weekends and holidays • Have 8 days in advance to make reservations for tee times • Can play at any time if accompanied by a Class "A" or Spousal Member
Yearly Cart Membership	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Covers the cost of 1 person • Covers the cost of 2 persons for couples • Guests must pay an individual cart rental

Rules & Regulations – General Matters

All categories of players must adhere to the Club's rules & regulations on golf play and Clubhouse decorum. All members and guests are required to register in the golf shop (15 minutes) before play begins. All players must have a tee time and start at the #1 tee unless otherwise instructed, play in more than foursomes is prohibited unless approved by the Pro Shop. The Pro-Shop shall have full responsibility and authority for starting players and regulating play. Their decisions are final including removal of players not following the rules & regulations.

Miscellaneous Club Services

A full fleet of electric carts will be on hand for your riding convenience, carts shall be operated on paths whenever possible. Directional signs placed to control carts must be observed. All carts must be returned to the cart drop off area after completion of play.
